X-UBERANCE

X-Uberance has consistently grown bigger and better with each passing year, celebrating skills, interests, and learning beyond the boundaries of textbooks. Being a fest like no other, X-Uberance has garnered a reputation of the "Biggest School Fest by the Biggest School in East India." X-Uberance '25 is committed to carrying forward this rich Xaverian legacy and will be a resounding success.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each school must be represented by two students who must be present throughout the fest.
- WhatsApp groups for the school representatives will be formed which will also comprise the administration. This group shall act as a medium for the clearance of all doubts and queries regarding a particular event or the fest in general.
- All information in regard to the fest and specific events will be conveyed via official channels such as WhatsApp groups.
 Participants and representatives shall use these groups as a medium for clearance of all doubts.
- 50 points will be awarded to schools that have 20 or more students attending the opening ceremony.
- School Uniform along with School ID cards is mandatory for all participants and non-participants unless specified otherwise.
- All events, unless specified otherwise, are open for participation to the students of classes 9 to 12.
- Decorum and norms of decency must be maintained at all times. Inappropriate behavior in violation of the code of conduct of the School shall not be entertained and appropriate measures shall be taken to curb the same.
- Schools participating in all the events will receive extra points.
- If a school participates in both the boys and girls event for the same sport, the total points received by the school will be the average of both.
- The average points awarded to a school participating in both boys' and girls' category of an event will be taken into account for the final points tally.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Points will be deducted for violation of school rules, X-Uberance '25 guidelines or indulging in any inappropriate behaviour.
- All participants are expected to refrain from using unfair means while participating in their respective events.
- The decision of the judges and referees' will be final and binding.
- Violation of the rules and regulations of the fest will result in a penalty and may lead to disqualification from the event or the fest.
- Team X-Uberance '25 reserves the right to publish and reproduce any content and publications associated with X-Uberance '25.
- Commercialisation of passes and other material associated with
 - X-Uberance '25 shall not be entertained. Strict action will be taken against the offenders.
- Any grievance or issue in regard to the fest or otherwise can be raised with the members of the Core Committee. The Core Committee shall resolve all concerns to the best of its ability.
- The decision of the Core Committee and the School Authorities is final and binding.
- All rights are reserved.

SECURITY PROTOCOL

- All participants must be in their school uniform and carry a
 valid school ID card / School Calendar of the year 2025-26 or a
 bonafide certificate from the school throughout the duration
 of the fest.
- Any volunteer and non-participating students from any school must also be in their school uniform and carry a valid school ID card or School Calendar of the year 2025- 26.
- Attendees and participants consent to having their bags and other belongings inspected and be frisked before being allowed admission / during stay / on exit.
- The following items are banned from the fest. Possession of the following items shall be strictly dealt with. The contraband will be confiscated and not returned. The offender will be denied admission into the school campus. The school authorities of the offender shall be notified.
 - 1. Drugs
 - 2. Cigarettes/Tobacco/Hookah/E-cigarettes
 - 3. Alcohol
 - 4. Any narcotics without prescription
 - 5. Any packaged food and beverage item
 - 6. Any sharp object
 - 7. Any other objectionable items
- Any objectionable item (Prescription Drugs / Props / Event Equipment etc.) shall only be allowed for exceptional cases, on prior intimation and permission from the Core Committee.
- Attendees and Participants must be in decent attire throughout the duration of the fest.

SECURITY PROTOCOL

- Participants, along with the School Representatives, must register themselves at the registration desk before admission.
- St. Xavier's Collegiate School will not be liable for any loss or damage of personal property.
- Participants or Attendees found in violation of the Security
 Protocol shall be strictly dealt with and shall be expelled from the school campus and not be allowed re-entry.
- The decision of Heads of Security, the Core Committee, and the School Authorities is final and binding.

SPORTING EVENTS



Venue: Primary School Field

Participants: 6 + 4 (substitutes)

Duration: 10 minutes per half + Extra Time

- The Tournament will have a separate event for boys and girls.
- The Tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- Participants must carry their official football attire, school jersey and kit.
- Inclusion of the school logo and number on the jersey is mandatory.
- If the match ends in a draw, penalty shootouts will take place as best of 3 followed by sudden death.
- Teams are allowed to make rolling substitutions.
- The referees' decision is final and binding.
- · School must submit all team line-ups before the event begins.



Venue: Basketball Court

Participants: 5 + 4 (Substitutes)

Duration: 7 minutes per half + 1 timeout per half each

team

- The Tournament will have a separate event for boys and girls.
- The Tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- Every team will carry their official school jerseys and kit.
- The inclusion of the school logo and number on the jersey is mandatory .
- Rolling substitutions are allowed.
- The referees' decision is final and binding.
- Each team is permitted to take one timeout per half.
- The match will be divided into four quarters, each quarter will have a 30 second break.
- · A half and timeout will have a one minute break.
- School must submit all team line ups before the event.
- If the team arrives late then a walkover shall be given.



Venue: Backfield & Primary School Field

Participants: 12

Duration: 9 minutes

- · The tournament will have a separate event for boys and girls.
- Each team has 12 players, with 9 on the field at a time. Three players shall serve as reserves.
- Each innings will be of 9 minutes.
- Rolling substitutes will be allowed.
- Each school must play in proper attire.
- No spikes or studs will be allowed.
- Officials' decision will be final.



Venue: Big Parlour

Participants: 2

Duration: 5/0(Blitz)

- · The team may consist of both boys and girls.
- The tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- The participants must be in school uniform throughout the tournament.
- An extra round is to be played in case of a draw.
- Rules and regulations of FIDE will be followed.
- Arbitrary decisions will be final and binding.
- The school must submit all team line-ups before the event begins to the event head.
- The duration of the semi-finals and finals will be 10/0(Rapid).



Venue: Games Room

Participants: 4

- The tournament will have a separate event for boys and girls.
- The tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- Each match shall be a best of 3 games.
- All the games will be of 11 points.
- A team winning the first two singles, the doubles will not be played.
- Players are requested to carry their own racquets.
- Rules and regulations of TTFI will be followed.
- The referees' decision is final and binding.
- The school must submit all team line-ups before the event begins.



Venue: Senior School Field

Participants: 10 + 2 (Substitute)

Duration: I minute per pull

- The tournament will have a separate event for boys and girls.
- The tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- · The participants must carry their school jerseys.
- The inclusion of the school logo on the jersey is mandatory.
- All the pulls will be best of 3.
- The participants are not allowed to wear spikes.
- Other rules to be given on the day of the event.
- The school must submit all team line-ups before the event begins.



Venue: Backfield

Participants: 6 + 3 (substitutes)

- The tournament is an event only for boys.
- The tournament will be on a knockout basis. The participants must carry their school jerseys.
- The matches will be best of 3 sets.
- · All the sets will be of 11 points each.
- The final will have 3 sets of 15 points each.
- The teams are allowed to make rolling substitutions.
- The referees' decision is final and binding.
- All the schools must submit all team line-ups before the event begins.



Venue: Backfield Participants: 10

- The tournament is an event only for girls.
- Each team should consist of a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 12 players. A substitution can be made only when the ball is not in play.
- Rotation is compulsory.
- Service is within five seconds after the referee's whistle. A player cannot jump while serving the ball. Double touch is not allowed when receiving the service ball, and players stay in the 3-3 position during the serve.
- The ball is thrown within three seconds of being caught, only from above the shoulder line and with one hand. A player can jump while throwing the ball, and the player should contact the ground while receiving it.
- The ball should not touch any part of the body other than the palm when catching
 or throwing. A team may touch the ball three times to deliver it into the opposite
 field (i.e. after two passes the third ball must be played [thrown or smashed] into the
 opposite field).
- The referees' decision is final and binding.
- In case of any discrepancies, the decision of the organizing committee will be final.



Venue: Senior School Field

Participants: 6 + 2 (rolling substitutes) + 2 (normal

substitutes)

- The tournament is an event only for boys.
- The tournament will be on a knockout basis.
- All the rules of the game will be declared on the day of the event itself.
- The participants must carry their official cricket attire, school jersey and kit. Abdomen guard is mandatory.
- The inclusion of the school logo and number on the jersey is mandatory.
- Each innings will be of 4 overs (one bowler can bowl up to 2 overs).
- The teams are allowed to make rolling substitutions.
- Exceeding time limit provided per inning will be strictly dealt with and may lead to deduction of runs from the team's total.
- The umpires' decision is final and binding.
- All team line-ups must be submitted before the event begins.

OFF-STAGE EVENTS



Venue: Fr. Bruylant's Hall

Participants: 1+1

Duration: 5 minutes per half

- The matches will be held on PS5 on EAFC 25.
- The tournament will be played on a knockout basis.
- If a match ends in a draw, penalties will decide the winner. No Extra time will be played.
- All other rules will be mentioned on spot.
- The rules are subject to change.



Venue: Xavier hall

Participants: 4

- There are 8 rounds for this event.
- Rules specific to different rounds of the event to be given on the day of the event.



Venue: Art Room

Participants: 1

Duration: 2 hours + 30 minutes (Uploading time)

- Participants must carry their own devices.
- Participants are required to mail the prepared files to the official mail ID.
- Acceptable file formats: .jpg/.jpeg/.png/.pdf
- The base file is to be submitted along with the .jpg file if possible.

 Base files should be retained till results are announced.
- · Any software is permitted.
- No Al generated images will be permitted.
- Topic will be announced to all the participants 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the event.



Venue: Reading Room

Participants: 2

Duration: 3+2 minutes

- Players List and Corpus amount will be provided a day prior to the event.
- · The participants are expected to bring their own laptops.
- There will be 2 rounds in the event. The 1st round will be the bidding round, where each team has to purchase their players within the given corpus amount. This will be followed by a Pitching round of 3+2 minutes which will include a Q&A session.
- Further rules and event flow for the bidding round will be specified on the day of the event.
- A total of one hour will be given to all the teams to prepare their Presentation which shall be mailed to a given email id at the completion of 30 minutes.
- Wifi shall not be provided by the host school.



X-CHOLOCHITRO

BENGALI SHORT FILM

Venue: Xavier Hall

Participants: 4

Duration: 8+2 mins

- Students will be asked to prepare short films in Bengali, completely edited and refined, to be sent to the respective event heads one day before the commencement of the fest.
- Each film has a maximum time limit of 10 minutes.
- The theme will be provided approximately a week and half before the fest.
- Each team can have a maximum of four members The short film must be completely original and devoid of any formerly used storylines.



Venue: Computer Lab 2nd Floor

Participants: 2

- Each participant has to bring their own devices.
- The topic will be given I day prior to the event and the participants must develop an app or a website that addresses the given problem statement.
- Use of no code tools is not allowed.
- Use of AI tools like ChatGPT, Github Copilot, etc. is allowed.
- Each team is required to make a presentation of their idea and submit it by 11:00 A.M. on Day 2.



Venue: Big Parlour

Participants: 2

Duration: 1 hour+15 minutes


- Participants are required to make 1 drink, 1 snack/starter and 1 dessert.
- Participants have to bring their own materials, including ingredients, cutlery, serving plates and glasses.
- All meals must be prepared without the use of fire.
- Equipment such as inductions and cook-tops cannot be used.
- The food prepared should be vegetarian.
- The use of alcohol is prohibited.
- Boiled vegetables, prepared sauce and plain cakes/biscuits can be brought for the event.
- Judging Criteria: Taste, Flavor, presentation, originality and cleanliness.



Venue: All Campus

Participants: 2 (Representative's Event)

- Only the representatives from each school are allowed to take part in the event.
- The final clue for all the schools will be the same.
- The ending point for all the schools will be the same.
- Participants are not allowed to interact with anyone except their school-in-charges during the treasure hunt.
- Participants will not be allowed to use their mobile phones during the event.



X-HIBIT DISPLAY OF SCIENCE MODELS

Venue: Big Parlour

Participants: 3

- This is a formal science exhibition.
- Students are required to present science-based models or projects that demonstrate scientific concepts, applications or innovations.
- The topic for the event will be given one week prior to the event.
- The participants will have to explain their model on the day of the event.



Venue: Fr. Bruylant's Hall

Participants: 2

- X-Investia is a finance event where teams manage a ₹3 crore portfolio by real-time decision-making in a physical trading simulation.
- Participants will trade mid-cap and small-cap stocks based on live market cues and news updates, aiming to grow their corpus through smart analysis, strategy, and adaptability.
- Trading will be conducted physically in a simulated market not online.
- A stock list will be circulated. Participants are requested to go through the basic fundamentals of the given companies.
- Laptops are allowed for tracking the corpus.
- This event is only for students of classes 11-12.
- Further details will be revealed during the event.



Venue: Xavier Hall Participants: 2 + 1

- No. of rounds: 3
- The specific rules of round one will be declared to the participants three days before the event.
- The rules for the rest of the event will be declared on the day itself.
- · Judging criteria will not be revealed.
- This event is only for students of classes 11-12.



Venue: School Campus

Participants: 2

- 5 themes will be given, out of which participants can choose any 2 themes and 1 theme will be compulsory.
- All the themes will be given on spot. Submissions have to be done via pen drive.
- Only DSLRs, SLRs and mirrorless cameras are allowed.
- Basic editing and touch-ups will be accepted.
- Using filters and presets is not allowed.
- All necessary equipment like cameras, laptops and pen drives must be brought by the participants.
- Participants have to provide a relevant caption for every picture submitted.
- Judging Criteria: Caption, Relevance to Theme, Creativity,
 Originality.



Venue: Big Parlour

Participants: 2

Duration: 2 hours

- The participants will have to make posters about the designated topic.
- They must bring their own material for the poster.
- The poster should be made on chart paper.
- The students will have 5 minutes to express the idea of their posters to the judges.
- The topic will be given via lucky draw on the day of the event.
- Judging criteria : Design, Creativity.



Venue: Art Room

Participants: 1

Duration: 2 hours

- The participants will be getting 2 hours to finish their artwork.
- · The drawing sheet will be provided.
- Participants need to bring their own stationery.
- Use of obscene imagery will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Theme will be provided 15 minutes prior to the event.
- Judging criteria: Creativity, Technique, Style, Relevance to the theme.



Venue: Xavier hall

Participants: 3

Duration: 2 hours

- No. of Rounds: 3
- Only after completing one round can the team move to the next.
- The Team, after finishing all the rounds correctly are to press a buzzer.
- The top three teams will be declared winners.
- Use of mobile phones, calculation or external assistance is strictly prohibited.
- Results will be announced during the closing ceremony.
- Judging criteria: Sudoku, Crossword Puzzle, Puzzle of Maths.



Venue: Fr. Sassel Hall

Participants: 3

- · No of rounds: 2.
- First round will be a written preliminary round.
- · Second round will be the finals.
- Further rules will be explained by the QuizMaster before the event.
- · Street scoring system will be followed.



X-RAPPORTEUR VLOGGING AND JOURNALISM

Venue: All Campus

Participants: 2

Duration: 10 + 5 minutes

- On Day 2, all schools must submit their videos.
- The video should have a proper balance between vlogging and journalism.
- The duration of the video should be 10+5 minute.
- Each school must carry their own laptops which will be connected to the projector.
- Each school must save their final videos in a pen drive and carry it to the venue where their final videos shall be displayed. The schools will be notified about the venue duly.
- The host school shall not be responsible for malfunctioning of the pendrives.
- Any sort of vulgarity will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Participants have to bring their own vlogging equipment.
- Participants would be required to record all their interviews on camera.
- Judging Criteria: Content, Balance, Quality of Interviews.



Venue: Instagram

Participants: 1+1

Duration: 30 to 60 seconds

- Each school has to submit one reel, 11 days prior to the beginning of the fest.
- The school reps should notify the Core Committee Event Head atleast 24 hours prior to the submission of the reel, mentioning the Instagram handle of the participant that will be posting the reel.
- The reels should be made on a non-objectionable audio track.
- The reel must be posted as a collaborative post on the social media account of a student from the participating school. The reel posted will be in collaboration with the official X-Uberance 25 Instagram account for a span of 72 hours.
- · Vulgarity of any sort will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Judging Criteria: Editing, Content, Overall impact, Public Appeal,
 Creativity.



Venue: Reading Room

Participants: 1+1

Duration: 1 hour + (3+1) minutes

- The Mode of language used will be English and Hindi.
- The participants will get 1 hour for preparation and 3+1 minutes for the recital of their writing.
- Use of unparliamentary language will lead to immediate disqualification.
- The Topics will be decided via lucky draw.
- Judging criteria: Vocabulary, Content, Use of Rhetorics, Creativity, Body Language, Enunciation.



Venue: Fr. Sassel Hall

Participants: 2

Duration: 5 minutes

- The participants are permitted to be dressed in either school uniform or any appropriate apparel they deem fit for their performance.
- The audio-drama should be primarily in Bengali language.
- No power point presentation allowed.



Venue: Primary School Gymnasium

Participants: 1

Duration: 2 hours

- The canvas will be provided.
- Participants need to bring their own stationery.
- Use of obscene imagery will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Spray Painting will be done on a 30"/36" canvas.
- Theme will be provided 15 minutes prior to the event.
- Judging criteria: Creativity, Technique, Style, Relevance to the theme.

ON-STAGE EVENTS



Venue: Fr. Bruylant's Hall

Participants: 1

Duration: 1 minute

- Participants must present an original and innovative act.
- Participants cannot exceed the time limit.
- Any form of uncivilized conduct will result in immediate disqualification.
- The final score will be based on the judges' scores.
- Judging criteria: Creativity, Originality, Skill, Composition, Technique.



Participants: 5+2

Duration: 4+1 minutes

- The topics and companies will be allotted via lucky draw during Representatives' Meet.
- The use of vernacular language is allowed, however, discouraged.
- The use of obscene language and gestures will lead to immediate disqualification.
- · The participants will have to bring their own props.
- Judging criteria: Originality, Script, Content, Expressions, Delivery.
- Exceeding the time limit will lead to point deduction.



Participants: 5+3

Duration: 8+2 minutes

- The 5 participants must be present on stage at all times.
- The participants will have to bring their own instruments.
- · Acoustic drums and sound system will be provided.
- Pre-recorded music will not be allowed.
- Inappropriate lyrics will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Each school will be allotted a band which will be given out in the reps meet via lucky draw.
- The timing will commence from the moment the stage is vacant until the subsequent participant assumes their position on stage.
- Judging Criteria: Synchronization, Music, Stage presence, Audience engagement.



Venue: Fr. Sassel Hall

Participants: 2

Duration: 3+1 minutes

- Participants may choose self-composed or published poems. If a published poem is selected, the name of the poet must be clearly acknowledged during the recitation.
- The poem's content must not contain offensive, derogatory or politically sensitive matters..
- Reading from a sheet or mobile devices is discouraged and may result in deduction of marks.
- Judging Criteria: Pronunciation and Fluency, Voice Modulation and Expressions, Stage Presence and Adherence to Time Limit.



Venue: Fr. Sassel Hall, Xavier's Hall

Participants: 2

- All schools will be divided into 2 pools in the first round.
- 1 participant for the motion and 1 participant against the motion.
- Standard Oxford rules (3+1 minute speech and rebuttals are allowed) will be followed.
- Preparation time of 1 hour is to be provided. Motion to be given at 1pm.
- Pools to be divided by lottery system for the first round at 1:00 am sharp.
- 2 teams from each pool will qualify for the 2nd round.
- 4 teams of 2 participants each will compete in an Oxford debate style.
- Preparation time of 1 hour is to be provided.
- Finals: 3 + 1 minute speech and a 2 minute rebuttal.
- House vote will decide the winning stance of the motion.
- Judging criteria: Content, Delivery, Relevance, Reasoning, Rebuttal.



Venue: Fr. Bruylant's Hall

Participants: 1

Duration: 20 + 10 + 2 minutes

- The topic for writing the story will be provided 15 minutes prior to the commencement of reading time.
- The participants will have to formulate their story within these 20 minutes, on a sheet which will be provided to them.
- The students will be allowed to write their story in the form of pointers on the parchment, but no paragraphs are to be written and read out.
- Students found to be reading out their stories completely from their text will be negatively marked by the judges.
- The students will be receiving 10 minutes of rehearsal time after the 20 minutes of formulation time, to rehearse their recital of their respective pieces.
- Students are to use bengali vernacular and are to be dressed in full school uniform.
- The time limit for recital will be 90 seconds per school, with a buffer time of 30 seconds.



Venue: Primary School Gymnasium

Participants: 2

- The event will be on a knockout basis.
- Commandos will be allowed in the finals. (Optional and no extra points will be provided for this).
- Inappropriate clothing can lead to disqualification.
- Participants, if needed, have to bring their own props.
- Both the participants can choose any dance form of their choice.
- A list of 25 forms will be provided to the participants 3 days prior to the event.
- Judging Criteria: Choreography, Audience engagement, Coordination, Originality, On-stage aggression.



Venue: Xavier Hall

Participants: 2

Duration: 3+1(including Q&A)

- This event will consist of two rounds.
- The industry in which the startup is to be based will be allotted at the Representative's Meet.
- In the 1st round the participants will have to prepare a PowerPoint
 Presentation containing a unique startup idea. This has to be mailed to
 the event head prior to the event.
- The top 8 will qualify to the next round.
- In the 2nd round each school will be allotted a company via lucky draw.
- Schools will receive I hour to form a joint venture with another school & prepare a pitch & PowerPoint Presentation for the joint venture.
- This event is only for students of classes 11-12.
- Judging Criteria: Product viability, Originality, Pitching skills, Designs,
 Financials.



Participants: 6+2

Duration: 5+2 minutes

- 6 participants must be present on stage at all times.
- No inappropriate lyrics to be included in the song used for the performance.
- All the tracks to be played will have to be sent to the fest's official email address a week before the fest.
- Vulgar or indecent costumes will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Points shall be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
- Judging Criteria: Choreography, Coordination, Costume, Audience engagement, Stage presence.



Participants: 6+2

Duration: 5+3 minutes

- Soft copy of the script needs to be mailed to the given email id 48 hrs prior to the event.
- It must be from a Bengali literary play or a scene from a play.
- 4 standing mics will be provided to each school.
- · No plug in facilities to be allowed.
- If schools want to include music as a component of their play, they
 must play it live. Any recordings or downloaded music cannot be
 used.
